- No business objective will take priority over health and safety;
- All injuries are preventable;
- No task is so important that it cannot be done safely;
- Every individual in our workplace is responsible for workplace health and safety.

Responsibility

To achieve an injury and illness free working environment, MSS Top Management are committed to:

- Managing the implementation and maintenance of the Occupational Health and Safety Management System in accordance with ISO 45001:2018;
- Fulfilling and complying with Legal requirements and other requirements;
- Ensuring OH&S risks are appropriately eliminated and minimised by taking effective preventive and protective measures;
- Providing information, instruction and training to enable all workers to work safely;
- Monitoring, measuring, analyzing and evaluating performance to enhance OH&S performance;
- Establishing, implementing and maintaining processes for consultation and participation of workers and representatives at all applicable levels and functions.
